

Competitive Educational Scholarship

The Wisconsin Energy Efficient Vehicle Association (WEEVA) and MasterGraphics seeks to encourage high school students to pursue careers in Technology Related fields by providing financial assistance in the form of (2) \$500 scholarships and (5) \$300 scholarships. These are competitive in selection.

Eligibility:

- (a) The applicant must be a high school Junior or Senior.
- (b) The applicant must be a participant of a current Wisconsin Supermileage and/or Electrathon Team.
 - a. Letter of recommendation required of Advisor
- (c) The applicant must be a Wisconsin resident.
- (d) The applicant must have fulfilled the proper requirements for acceptance of this scholarship listed below.
- (e) The applicant must be pursuing further education for a career related to technology in a post-secondary educational institution located within the United States. (2-year and 4-year programs acceptable, all students are encouraged)

Requirements:

- (a) Completed Application Form
- (b) 250 - 500 word essay with the focus around your Supermileage and/or Electrathon experiences.
 - a. Topics to consider including are: professional & skill development, past and future goals, best experience on the team, desired career path.
- (c) Copy of High School Transcripts & High School Attendance Records
- (d) (2) Two letters of recommendation prior to the application deadline.
 - a. One of which is from your advisor and Second is a non-relative adult.

Selection Process:

- (a) Applicants will be judged on the basis of the information provided in the application, school records, personal essay, and letters of recommendation.
- (b) All applications received prior to the application deadline will be reviewed and scored by the WEEVA Scholarships and Awards Committee. The committee will select the scholarship recipients.

Award Procedures:

- (a) The recipients will receive payment in full of their scholarship upon written confirmation of institution desired.
- (b) The check will be mailed to the student and made payable to BOTH the student and the college or university.
- (c) Awardees may be posted on the WEEVA website with pictures and a write-up of themselves.
- (d) Notification of awardees will be by July 31st, after the WEEVA Summer Board Meeting.

Instructions:

- (a) Complete the top half of the Application Form & Sign the authorization line.
- (b) Have your school official complete the school certification section.
- (c) Write a 250 – 500 word essay focusing on your experiences with the Supermileage/Electrathon Challenges in WI.
- (d) Provide a letter of recommendation from your Team Advisor
- (e) Provide a letter of recommendation from one other adult. (non-relative)
- (f) Provide a legal copy of your high school transcript and school attendance records for grades 9 – present.
- (g) Place all of the items above in the same 9 x 12 envelope and mail to:
